At the discretion of the Chief Referee, events may be combined to allow skaters the chance to compete, if this is not possible, single entries will be offered the opportunity to skate against the book standard which would allow them to skate in the Championship Round or receive a refund for the event not skated..

- Rink Size:** 200' x 100' with rounded corners (standard Olympic size).
- Lighting:** Spotlights will be available for entry with submission of a "Request for Spotlight" form\*. Barrier lights will be used. If there is no form submitted the House Lights will be used.
- Admission:** Daily passes - \$5.00 Senior Citizen (65+) Daily Pass - \$2.00,  
Children 5 and under Free. Children under 10 yrs. must be accompanied by an adult.  
You will find a Chaperone Pass Request at the bottom of Spotlight Form. One (1) Pass per skater 18 years of age and under. Lost Passes will be replaced for a fee of \$10.00
- Showcase Categories:** Artistic events may combine US Figure Skating and ISI skaters at equivalent skill levels.  
Competitors may skate up one level.

- Eligibility:** Open to currently registered Eligible and Reinstated US Figure Skating Skaters and ISI skaters. All skaters in Preliminary and Adult Bronze levels and above placing 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, or 4<sup>th</sup> in their group will be eligible to enter the **2012 U.S. National Showcase Championships.**

**Entry Forms:**

Complete the appropriate forms in the Entry Form Packet making sure that the Skater information is complete, all events to be entered are identified, and required signatures are present. For age restricted events, age eligibility is subject to verification.

**Duets: each skater must submit a separate Entry Form but mail forms and fees together.**

**Entry Fees:**

Please refer to the enclosed Entry Form Packet for a schedule of fees.

**Late Entries:**

Entries received after the deadline of March 3, 2012 are considered late entries and are subject to a \$25 late fee. Entry will be accepted or declined at the discretion of the Chief Referee. No entries will be accepted after the groupings and draw.

**Change of Event Requests:**

There will be a \$25 fee to change events or levels after the close of entry.

**Cancellations and Refunds:**

Any withdrawal request received prior to February 29, 2012 will be eligible for a refund and **subject to a \$10.00 processing fee**. No refunds will be given after March 3, 2012 unless the event is not held. US Figure Skating rule #3235.

**Returned Checks:**

There will be a \$40 charged for all returned checks.

**Practice Ice:**

**Competition Schedule:**

It is left to the discretion of the Chief Referee as to order, time and day of each event. Skaters should be prepared to skate at any time that their event may be scheduled. A tentative schedule will be available on the Tri-Valley Figure Skating Club website, [www.tvfsc.org](http://www.tvfsc.org) approximately one week prior to the event. The tentative schedule of events is subject to change.

**Official Schedule:**

The Official Schedule will be posted on the Official Bulletin Board or at the Registration Table located in the rink lobby during the event. All changes to the schedule will be noted on the posted Official Schedule and will serve as due notice. Please check the Official Bulletin Board frequently.

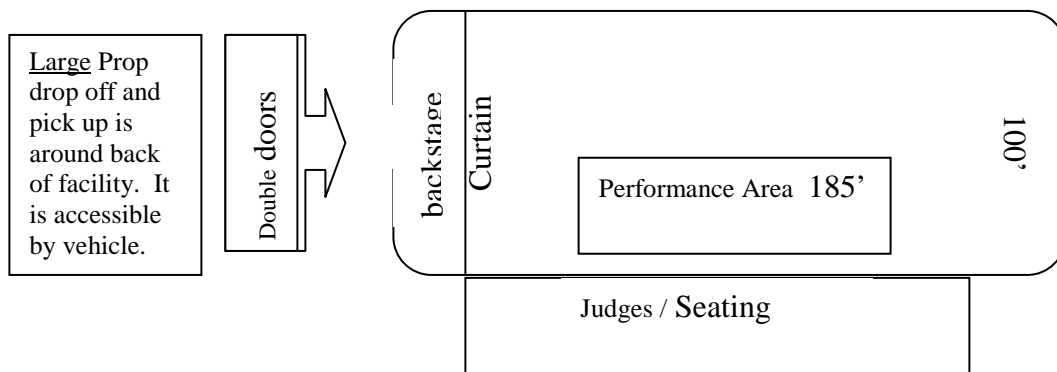
**Check-in:**

All skaters must check in with the Registration Desk 60 minutes before the scheduled time of their event. **Events may begin as much as 15 minutes before the scheduled starting time at the Chief Referee's discretion. Skaters must check in with the Ice Monitor 30 minutes before they are scheduled to skate.**

**\*Extemporaneous / Interpretation** competitors must report to the assigned Locker Room at least 20 minutes prior to start of event to listen to music.

**Music:**

**Standard format CD's** (no CDRW's). Each CD must have only one program on it, clearly labeled with name, level, and program length. Music must be turned in to the Registration Desk at the time of check-in for the event. The Tri-Valley Figure Skating Club is not responsible for badly recorded music or scratched or abused CD's.

**SKATERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR HAVING A BACKUP CD.**

Skaters advancing to the Championship round will pick up their music after the Championship round event. Music CDs will not be saved after the competition's final event concludes.

**Dressing Rooms:**

Dressing rooms are unsupervised. Please bring skate guards, and do not leave valuables unattended. US Figure Skating, Tri-Valley Figure Skating Club nor Iceoplex Simi Valley will **NOT** be responsible for missing valuables.

**Skater Advancement:**

**Dramatic and Light Entertainment:** The first place winner from each group will advance to the Championship round plus one (1) additional **may be nominated by judges.**

**Extemporaneous/Interpretive:** The 1<sup>st</sup> place winner of each Extemporaneous/Interpretive group will advance to the Championship Round plus one (1) **may be nominated by judges.**

**Duets/Couples:** The 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> place winners of each Duet/Couple group will advance to the Championship Round plus one (1) **may be nominated by judges.**

**Mini-Ensemble/Production/Synchronize:** The 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners from each group will advance to the Championship Round plus one (1) **may be nominated by judges.**

**\*\*Important: If the 1st place winner chooses not to advance to the Championship round then the 2<sup>nd</sup> place winner will advance.**

**THE SCOTT HAMILTON AWARD** is awarded to the First Place winner in the Singles Light/Dramatic Division.

**THE RICHARD DWYER AWARD** is awarded to the First Place winner in the Extemporaneous Division.

**THE TAI BABILONIA AWARD** is awarded to the First Place winners in the Duet Division.

**THE STILLWELL AWARD** is awarded to the First Place winners in the Mini-Ensembles & Production & Synchronize Division.

**THE BONNIE MARTIN AWARD** is awarded to the First Place winner in the Tot through Pre-Preliminary Division.

**Awards:** 1. ISI Showcase Events: Medals for 1<sup>st</sup> thru 4<sup>th</sup> place. Ribbons for 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>  
2. USFS Showcase Initial Round Events: Medals for 1<sup>st</sup> thru 4<sup>th</sup> place.

**Perpetual Awards:** The winner of each special award will not be posted; Winners will be announced and awards will be presented on ice. On Ice presentations will be scheduled prior to ice resurfacing during the competition

## SHOWCASE EVENTS

**Theatrical elements evaluated:** Performances will be judged for theatrical and artistic qualities, from an entertainment standpoint. Technical skating skill and difficulty will not be rewarded as such; however, skating must be the major element of the performance and of sufficient quality to support the theatrical elements chosen: Energy, poise, acting, gestures, eye contact, choreography, form, extension, and the use of costumes, ice and props.

**Judging System for All Showcase Events**

Marks will be awarded by each judge in the following 3 categories: 1) Skating Skills/Transitions, 2) Performance & Execution, and 3) Choreography/Interpretation. No technical skating mark will be used

**Deductions/Penalties Showcase Events:**

There will be a 1.0 deduction for each 10 seconds in excess of the maximum performance time. Timing starts with the first motion of the body – hand, head, skate, etc. **Poorly executed skating elements and obvious losses of control will reduce competitor's marks.**

**Props and scenery:**

Must be placed and removed by single and duet competitors in a total time of 1 minute; by Mini-ensembles and Production groups, in two minutes. **No assistance is allowed; violations will be penalized 1.0 for each 10 seconds excess time.**  
**Large Props:** To be brought around to back of arena and picked up by the end of the day. Props left overnight will be discarded.

**Safety:**

Props, scenery and costumes considered hazardous will not be allowed on the ice. Props may be inspected by Stage Director/Manger, Competitions Chair, Chief Referee or Assistant Referee for Safety. This prohibition includes the release of helium balloons. If a performer has any doubt concerning the safety of his/her number, the Stage Director/Manager or Competition Chairperson should be consulted.

**Extemporaneous/ Interpretative:**

Performances will be approximately 1:00 minute to 1minute 30 seconds in duration to facilitate choreography.

Groups may be **divided** or **combined** by age, draw, levels or gender at the discretion of the Chief Referee. Adult events will be broken into groups by age: Young Adult (18-24), I (25-35), II (36-45), III (46-55), IV (56 and over). Age groups may be combined at the discretion of the Chief Referee. Competitors may skate up one level higher than Freeskate Test passed.
