## GENERAL INFORMATION

- Competition Rules:** The competition will be conducted in accordance with the rules of the US Figure Skating as set forth in the current 2010-2011 US Figure Skating Rulebook, except as herein specified. Changes to the West Coast Open rules or schedules will be posted on the website at [www.tvfsc.org](http://www.tvfsc.org) and on the official bulletin board at Ice Station Valencia and will be considered sufficient notice to all competitors and officials. **Important: It will be the responsibility of the Coach and Competitor to check the US Figure Skating Website for current rule updates and clarifications.**
- Eligibility:** Open to eligible skaters in good standing with US Figure Skating, or Basic Skills or ISI and have written consent of a home club official or Skating School Director (see Entry Form). Each skater may compete at the level for which they are qualified under the US Figure Skating/ISI test rules as of the close of entries on September 1, 2010 **or one level higher**. The skater's age as of September 1, 2010 will determine the age requirements for all events.
- Rink Size:** 200' x 85' with rounded corners (standard NHL size).

For Pairs each skater must submit a separate Entry Form. Mail forms and fees together.  
All age requirements are effective as of the close of entries.

**\*\*\*Make sure you have marked the correct event(s). There will be a \$50.00 fee to change your event after the Groups have been established No Exceptions.**
- Late Entries:** Entries postmarked after the deadline of September 1, 2010 are considered late entries and will be accepted or declined at the discretion of the Chief Referee and if accepted will be subject to a late fee of \$50.00.
- Cancellations & Refunds:** There will be no refunds after the close of entries. If an event or the competition is cancelled refunds will be in accordance with rule 3233 and 3235.
- Returned Checks:** A \$35 fee will be charged for NSF / returned checks.
- Practice Ice:** Contact the Ice Station Valencia directly for additional freestyle and public session times at (805) 775-8686 or [www.icestation.net](http://www.icestation.net)
- Check-in:** All skaters must check in with the Registration Desk 60 minutes before the scheduled time of their event. Events may begin as much as 15 minutes before the scheduled starting time at the Chief Referee's discretion. Skaters must check in with the Ice Monitor 30 minutes before they are scheduled to skate.

- Music:** Skaters are to provide **CDs (standard CD format only, no re-recordable CDRW discs)** for their events. Each CD must have only one program on it, starting at the beginning and clearly marked with the skater's name, event, pro's name, and length of music. Music must be turned in to the Registration Desk at the time of check-in for the event. **Have a back-up copy available at rink-side in the event that there is a problem with the first CD.** Please pick up your music shortly after the event. Music CDs will not be saved after the competition's final event concludes.
- Groupings:** Tot through Pre-Juvenile will be grouped by age; Juvenile through Senior will be by random draw. Siblings will be separated when possible. At the discretion of the Chief Referee, levels and/or events may be combined to allow skaters the chance to compete, or single entries may be offered the opportunity to skate or request a refund. Male and female skaters may be combined in all events **except** US Figure Skating free skating events. The decision of the Chief Referee will be final. There will be no final rounds for standard Free Skate events. Showcase events will have a "Parade of the Champions" final round at the end of the competition.
- Awards:** **ISI:** Medals will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> thru 6<sup>th</sup> place winners.  
**No Test thru Pre-Juvenile Singles, Pre-Juv & Intern Pairs, Pre-Bronze & Bronze Adults:** Medals will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> thru 4<sup>th</sup> place winners.  
**Intermediate thru Senior Singles, Novice thru Senior Pairs & Dance:** Medals for 1<sup>st</sup> thru 4<sup>th</sup> place winners in S/P; Medals for 1<sup>st</sup> thru 4<sup>th</sup> place winners in Free Skate Program & Dance.  
**Trophies:** will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> thru 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners in the combined results for Short & Free Skate Program; 1<sup>st</sup> thru 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners in Juvenile / Open Juvenile, Adult Silver thru Gold Events & Solo Dance.  
**Showcase Programs:** Initial Rounds – Medals will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> thru 4<sup>th</sup> place winners in all events. Special Trophies will be awarded to the overall winner of the "Parade of the Champions" in the following categories: Dramatic/Light category, Extemporaneous Category, Duet Category, Ensemble Category and Young Adult, Adult Pre-Bronze, Adult Bronze, No Test & below category.
- Photos:** Pictures will be taken of the top four skaters in each event on the podium when the awards are given immediately following each event. Special Awards will be presented on Ice at the end of the competition. All skaters can arrange with the photographer for individual pictures. Digital action photos of each skater will also be available.
- Programs:** Souvenir programs will be available for purchase at the event.  
**Videos:** All skaters can arrange tapings with the official videographer at the event.

**A Planned Program Element Sheet for ALL Free Skate & Short Programs utilizing the IJS judging system must be submitted with your entry form.**
- Officials:** U.S. Figure Skating judges will be selected from the current U.S. Figure Skating list of Officials. I.S.I. events will be selected per I.S.I. rules and guidelines. Showcase judges may be selected from a list of U.S. Figure Skating judges, the theatrical field and/or perspective judges.

Note: It is permissible for one or both partners to have passed the next higher Pairs or Dance test and still remain eligible to compete at the lower level, provided that neither skater has competed at the higher Pair's or Dance level in qualifying competitions. Further, if the skater chooses to compete at the lower Pair's or Dance level they must do so with a partner other than the one with whom they passed the higher Pairs or Dance test.

## **ADULT AND YOUNG ADULT EVENTS**

**Age categories:** Young Adults events are open to skaters aged 18 to 20 years. Adult and Master's events are open to skaters age 18 and over. Adult age categories (i.e. Classes I to IV) may be divided or combined by age or gender at the Chief Referee's discretion:

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Adult free skate events will be skated in accordance to the current 2010-11 U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook. Time limits, as indicated on that table and herein, are maximums. There are no minimums. **Skaters may skate up one level** from what they are otherwise qualified for based on tests. Well-Balanced Program requirements shall apply. **Masters levels** may ultimately be combined by age or by level at the Chief Referee's discretion.

## **DANCE EVENTS**

Dance events and age requirements will be per Section 4470 thru 4505 in the U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook for the 2010-2011 Season. Rules governing the new "Solo" dance event will be per guidelines established for the National Solo Dance Championships. One dance will be drawn from each test level. Each group will skate 2 dances. Skaters will compete in flights at the discretion of the Referee. Eligible skaters will accumulate points for every solo dance. ## **SHOWCASE GENERAL RULES**

### **Events:**

**Dramatic Entertainment:** a serious emotional artistic interpretation;

**Light Entertainment:** any performance not serious enough to be considered dramatic;

**Extemporaneous/Improvisation:** a performance choreographed by the competitor, unaccompanied, to music supplied by the organizers. The music will be played during a 30 minutes off-ice session and twice during a warm-up on ice prior to the performance. All competitors in the group will interpret the same music.

**Duets:** theatrical/artistic performance by any two competitors;

**Mini Production Ensembles:** theatrical/artistic performance by three (3) to seven (7) competitors;

**Production Ensemble:** theatrical/artistic performance by eight (8) or more skaters. Theater on Ice teams are eligible as production ensembles.

\*\*Note – Skaters may enter only one each duet, mini production or production ensemble.

**Judging & Marking:** Performances will be judged from an entertainment standpoint, for theatrical and artistic qualities. Technical skating skills and difficulty will not be rewarded as such; however, skating must be the major element of the performance and be of sufficient quality to support the selected theatrical elements. A) Unintended falls, poorly executed skating elements and obvious losses of control will reduce competitors marks. B) Theatrical elements evaluated will include energy, poise, acting, pantomime, eye contact, choreography, form/extension and the use of props and ice. C) Three marks will be given by each judge for each performance: Skating Skills, Performance/Execution, Choreography/Interpretation.

### **Performance Times:**

- A) Extemporaneous / Improvisations: Approximately 1 – 1 ½ minutes
- B) Light and Dramatic:
  - 1. Tot Level thru FS 3 – 1minute 10 seconds maximum
  - 2. No Test thru Pre-Juvenile – 1minute 40seconds maximum
  - 3. Juvenile thru Novice – 2 minute 10 seconds maximum
  - 4. Junior and Senior – 2 minutes 40 seconds maximum
  - 5. Adult and Master events – 1 minute 40 seconds maximum
- C) Ensembles:
  - 1. Duets – Same as “B” above based upon level of the higher test skater
  - 2. Mini Production Ensembles – 3 minutes 10 seconds maximum
  - 3. Production Ensembles – 6 minutes 40 seconds maximum

**Props / Scenery / Costumes:** Must be placed and removed by unaided singles and duet competitors within one (1) minute, by unaided ensembles within two (2) minutes. A 1.0 deduction will be taken by the referee for each ten (10) seconds in excess of the time allowed for the performance and setting props and scenery. All sequins, beads, etc. must be securely fastened to the costume. Any delays due to beads and sequins falling off may result in a timing deduction under props and scenery timing allowances or disqualification.

### **Group Sizes, Initial and Final Rounds:**

- 1. Groups will not exceed ten (10) skaters. The first place winner in each group/level will advance to the “Parade of Champions” finals. If the first place winner chooses not to skate in the “Parade of Champions” then the second place winner will advance. Judges by majority may also nominate a skater to advance that has not placed first or second.
- 2. The “Parade of Champions” will be held for the Pre-Preliminary and higher plus Adult Silver/Gold/Masters Champions first place winners of the Dramatic and Light Entertainment events together.
- 3. The “Parade of Champions” will be held for all winners of the Extemporaneous / Improvisation events, Duet events and Mini/Production ensembles. Competitors may also be nominated by a majority of judges to advance to the Parade of Champions round. Champions will perform an encore of their winning performances except that new Extemporaneous music will be provided.
- 4. The “Parade of Champions” will be held for Tot thru No Test, Young Adult, Adult Pre-Bronze and Bronze of the Dramatic/Light entertainment events together.
- 5. Competitors advancing in both Light and Dramatic may skate both performances but will be awarded only the higher of the two placements.
- 6. A random skating order will be used in all rounds except the singles Parade of Champions. Those Parades will skate in an order approved by the Referee to meet the principles.

**Lighting:** Singles and Duets will warm up under house lighting and perform under spotlights in a dimmed house. Ensembles will warm up and perform under house lighting. If feasible, Extemporaneous/Improvisations will warm up under house lighting and perform under spotlights in a dimmed house. If not, then house lights will be used. Stage front lighting is optional; barrier lighting is required for safety.
